In addition, for Department of Transportation covered positions, APSC will also utilize urinalysis testing. Any positive drug test makes you ineligible for APSC employment.</li> <li>It is important to note that APSC does not seek or accept any genetic information as part of the hair testing procedure or any other process that could directly or inadvertently provide genetic information (family medical history).</li> </ul>
Employment Verification using E-Verify	<ul> <li>Federal Law requires all employers to verify identity and employment eligibility of all persons hired to work in the United States.
