ALYESKA INTERNSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION

Alyeska Pipeline Service Company (Alyeska) seeks highly-motivated college students currently attending an accredited university, participating in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in a variety of disciplines including:

- Accounting / Business / Economics / Finance
- Computer Science / IT / Management Information Systems
- Project Management
- Engineering (Civil/Electrical/Mechanical)

Alyeska is interested in hiring individuals seeking a future career-specific pathway to participate in a paid internship program in Alaska for a 12-16 week term (depending on assignment) on the Trans Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS). Internship positions may be available in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Valdez, and Pump Stations. Applicants must be eligible to work in the U.S. (refer to Page 3 of the Department of Homeland Security Employment Eligibility Verification (I-9) Form).

- Alaska residency (preferred)

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00

PRE-EMPLOYMENT DRUG SCREEN TESTING INFORMATION

Employment with Alyeska is contingent upon successfully passing a background investigation and physical examination. Alyeska requires pre-employment drug testing utilizing hair test collections for all positions. The preferred collection site is from the head (approximately 1/2 inch of hair length necessary), which provides an approximate 90-day window of detection that checks for prohibited drug use. Additionally, urinalysis testing is required for Department of Transportation covered positions. A positive drug test (to include alcohol screening) makes you ineligible for employment with Alyeska and on TAPS. It is important to note, Alyeska does not seek or accept any genetic information as part of the hair testing procedure or any other process that could directly or inadvertently provide genetic information (family medical history).
