



### What are the anticipated deadlines and timelines associated with the application and internship?

- Application packet deadline: **December 6, 2019**
- Internship orientation in Anchorage, Alaska: **May 18, 2020**
- Internship term: **May 18 – August 30, 2020**

### What do I need to submit to Alyeska to be considered for the internship?

- **A complete, typed internship application submitted via email.** Previous years' applications will not be accepted.
- **Current resume.** Include most recent educational, professional, and volunteer experience.
- **Copy of official college grade transcript.** Include official transcripts reflecting grades from previous semester if currently enrolled in fall 2019. Follow up by submitting an unofficial transcript **AFTER** completing the fall 2019 semester.
- **One letter of recommendation.** Dated within 12 months of current internship application. May be from a teacher, professor, supervisor, mentor, or other individual who you know on an educational or professional level. May **not** be from a family member, spouse or friend. References must include date, name and contact information of the person providing the reference. Although we prefer to receive application packets in their entirety from students, reference letters may be sent separately directly to us from the person providing the reference.
- **Personal Statement.** One page, double-spaced, 12 pt. font. State reasons for requesting internship. Summarize personal and educational accomplishments and demonstrated leadership experience. Explain how the degree program and internship correspond with career goals.
- **EEO Form (voluntary).** Alyeska has an equal opportunity affirmative action program. To help Alyeska in its efforts to comply with the reporting requirements, please complete and submit the voluntary EEO form.

**Does Alyeska accept unofficial grade transcripts, unsealed official grade transcripts, or electronic grade transcripts?** While grade transcripts must be official, i.e. signed or attested to by the school's registrar, we do not need the original sealed version and will accept a scanned or electronic copy of the official grade transcript. A link emailed directly from the school is most efficient.

**Can I send in my grade transcripts separately?** If you are currently enrolled in the fall 2019 semester, submit unofficial grade transcripts **AFTER** completing the semester.

**What type of internship will I be placed in?** Alyeska closely match interests and major with available assignments, which vary each year.

**How much will I be paid?** Hourly rates of pay are based upon education level (i.e., freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate).

**Does Alyeska provide travel to and from Alaska?** No. Interns are responsible for their own transportation to and from Alaska. Additionally, interns are responsible for their own transportation to and from each worksite except for the Pump Stations.

**Does Alyeska provide housing for interns?** Dorm housing is provided in Valdez, AK at the Prince William Sound Community College. However, Alyeska cannot guarantee availability beyond the first week in August. Housing is also provided at the Pump Stations for the entire internship period. Housing is not provided in Anchorage or Fairbanks.

**How will I know when my application is received?** Alyeska will send an email confirming receipt of a complete or incomplete application packet.

**How will I be contacted?** Alyeska will contact all applicants via email and/or phone.

**Does Alyeska hire international students?** Yes. However, applicants must be eligible to work in the United States. See pages 3 & 4 of the Department of Homeland Security, Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, which indicates the documents that must be provided to verify eligibility. **Does Alyeska require drug screening for Internships?** Alyeska requires pre-employment drug testing utilizing hair test collections for all positions. The preferred collection site is from the head (approximately 1/2 inch of hair length necessary). Head hair testing provides an approximate 90-day window of detection that checks for prohibited drug use. Additionally, urinalysis testing is required for Department of Transportation covered positions. Positive drug test results make applicants ineligible for employment with Alyeska or on TAPS. Alyeska does not seek or accept any genetic information as part of the hair testing procedure or any other process that could directly or inadvertently provide genetic information (family medical history).

**Does Alyeska perform background checks?** Yes, employment with Alyeska is contingent upon successfully passing a background investigation.

**Do I need a Transportation Worker Identification (TWIC) card to work for Alyeska as an intern?** A TWIC is required for internship assignments in Valdez. Valdez Marine Terminal (VMT) is a regulated facility. Employees hired to work on VMT or to provide emergency support or other approved work on VMT must have a TWIC card. An application, background check, scheduled appointment and fee applies. The fee for the TWIC card will be reimbursed by Alyeska.
