Provides technical input for planning and scheduling work activities with an emphasis on simultaneous operations, concurrent work, and resource sharing and identifying other opportunities to increase planning effectiveness. Ensures appropriate planning measures are initiated to assess, negotiate, and amend scope of work responsibilities, proposals, contracts, and budgets. Directs resolution of project and maintenance activity risks and issues compromising execution and leads development plans and actions to mitigate risks. Provides T5/T6 level expertise and knowledge to the Integrated Planning Manager to ensure all work is delivered consistent with the maintenance process. Ensures APSC standardized tools are used for work orders, planning, and scheduling.
